Sexual Health Update 2010 will cover common sexual health problems seen in primary care, including testing and treatment of common sexually transmitted infections, advances in diagnosis and common pitfalls in practice.

Additional topics this year include: bacterial vaginosis, urethritis that does not respond to treatment, androgens in female sexual dysfunction, and genital spots, lumps and sores. Several speakers will tackle the tricky issue of what to say to newly diagnosed patients with variously herpes, warts, HIV or hepatitis B.
